When he had come near Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called Mount of Olives, he sent two of the disciples, saying, "Go into the village ahead of you, and as you enter it you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks you, 'Why you are untying it? Just say this, "The Lord needs it." "Luke 19: 30-31

With these words Luke begins telling us about the week that we now call Holy Week. Holy Week is the remembrance of Jesus' last week of earthly life and all the events that led up to his death on a cross. At Central Rogers we emphasize the importance of walking through this powerful week together as a church. This year I want to encourage you to walk through this week with intentionality. I believe that has become one of my words this year. This word reminds us to slow down and act with purpose.

It can be so easy to rush through the week toward Easter because it is a busy time of year. But no matter what is going on in your life right now, I want to give you a few things to do Sunday April 2nd through Sunday April 9th.

- 1) Follow the story. Join us in worship on Sunday, April 2nd to walk through the events of Palm Sunday. Then spend some time each day reading our Lenten devotional and meditating on the scripture. As you do so think through what happened each day. You can access the Lenten devotional at centralrogers.com/lent
- 2) Join us on each of the holy days for worship services that will take you through the key moments of the story.
 - We will observe the events of the Last Supper during the Maundy Thursday Service at 6pm on Thursday, April 6th.
 - Our Chancel Choir will lead us in a time of remembering Jesus be crucified on Good Friday, April 7th at 7pm.

- -Worship with us on Easter Sunday as we celebrate the joy of an empty tomb and victory in this life that we find in Jesus Christ.
- 3) Pray this prayer, "Lord, let me understand what your Son did for me in a whole new way. Teach me through every event we walk through and help me fully to experience the power of the cross and the empty tomb."

I believe that if we walk through the week and Easter Sunday with intentionality, we will experience God in a fresh and renewing way. So, as we begin this powerful journey together, I invite you to join the Central Church family in asking God to speak and move within us.

One other way for us to be intentional this month is the Sunday following Easter Sunday. This year we will confirm a group of 8th graders on Sunday, April 16th. Because this is such a special day, we will be having one service in the sanctuary at 10:30 following Sunday School. The reason we are doing this is to surround our confirmands with the entire church. This communicates to them several important points

- 1. Central Rogers is supporting them in their decision to follow Jesus Christ.
- 2. Central Rogers will be serious about our covenant to help them walk in their faith to become the women and men God has created them to be.
- 3. Central Rogers takes seriously the Confirmation process and celebrates the commitments to God and the church that our youth make.

One more way to be intentional this month is to pray daily for Central. Pray for us to be the church God has called us to be. Pray that God will lead us, open doors for more ministry, and draw people to worship. I believe if we are intentional to pray this prayer together, we will see God move in our midst.

God bless you as you walk into this holy season and into Spring. As you walk through this month don't forget that you matter to God, and He wants to walk with you every step of the day.

There were vendors from 26 different organizations, including GROUP, whose VBS curriculum we use. Ms. Mollie and Mrs. Misty sure were excited to try out the Imagination Station kits and see this year's Bible buddies. We heard from Amy Davison of Mama Bear Apologetics and were so inspired by Keith Ferrin's Bible "internalization" (he can express entire books of the Bible from memory!). In between the main sessions, there were four different breakout opportunities, each with 8 classes to choose from. Some of our favorites were "Superpowers of a Great KidsMin Volunteer", "You CAN Teach Babies", "Starting a Special Needs Ministry" and "Discipleship Pathways from Infancy to Adolescence".
