As we enter February, the thing about the church calendar that stands out is Lent begins in the middle of February. Ash Wednesday is February the 14. Did you get that? Ash Wednesday is on Valentine's day! I have been looking at that and talking with our team about it for months. I have been wondering if there is something we could do to commemorate both? Should we have multiple times to get ashes so that people could also go on Valentine dates? Should we come up with a new greeting card that mixes both of them in a nice package. Or should we try to ignore that Valentine's is happening on this holy solemn day?

I think it is important to try to see what lesson we might learn from both holidays being on the same day. One that commemorates the solemn season of repentance and humility to prepare ourselves for Easter. The other was declared in 496 by Pope Gelasius I of Rome to honor St. Valentine. There are several legends about St. Valentine and they have in common either brotherly love or sweetheart love. Even though the tone and focus of the holidays seem very different, isn't it pretty awesome though?

Why is it awesome? Because I believe the beginning of Lent teaches us something very important about love. The basis for being able to love someone comes from a humble right relationship with God. Valentine's focuses on the excitement, the mystery and even the cheesiness of love. But if those Valentine relationships are going to be all that they can be each person needs to love Jesus as their number one. In Christ we learn what love really is and in a relationship with Jesus, we are given through the Holy Spirit the ability to love well. This means loving when it is hard to love. Loving when things have changed. Loving even when you are not feeling loved.

The list of ways to love could go on and on. But the important thing is that what happens to us through the journey of Lent leads us into a deeper relationship with Christ. This deeper relationship will help us love better in all our relationships. So how about a Valentine's date made up of dinner provided by our youth followed by Ash Wednesday Service with ashes upon your head. That is how you bring the Valentine's heart together with the cross of Christ!

THE BIBLE RECAP ADVICE CORNER

Dear Wanting to start now,

It's no problem at all and it's great you want to jump in with Central Roger's reading plan. It does take a few steps on your phone or tablet. Here is what you do: If you have The Bible Recap plan on your You Version Bible app, leave this plan. You are able to LEAVE THE PLAN by pressing the three dots in the upper right corner and choosing this option in the drop down menu. Now go to the SETTINGS on your phone or tablet. Find Date and Time (which is normally under General Management), but if you can't find it you can simply search your settings for "date and time". Find the Automatic date and time setting and turn OFF. Set the date as January 1, 2024. Go back to the You Version Bible app and reload The Bible Recap plan and push START PLAN. It should show Day One and January 1st. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT! Go back to your Date and Time in Setting and turn ON the Automatic date and time. This should get you started on the same time frame as Central Rogers. If you have missed a few days or many days, just jump in on the date you are beginning. It will show you've missed days, but you are right were you need to be!



"HAVE FAITH" WOMEN'S CONFERENCE


